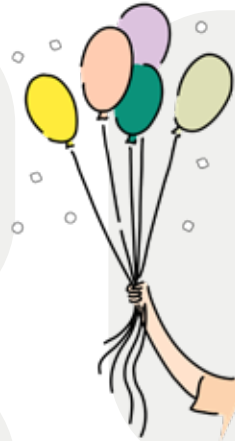
Staff engagement

Blue Light Events

TASC has been reaping the benefits of a partnership with a not-for-profit organisation set up after a member of the 999 services was forced to leave his job through injury. His organisation has now raised more than £10,000 in aid of four emergency services charities, namely TASC (The Ambulance Staff Charity), The Fire Fighters Charity, Flint House Police Rehabilitation Centre in Oxfordshire, and Sapper Support, a post-traumatic stress disorder helpline staffed by military veterans and 999 personnel.
